Provider training: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=G6cUmY_HQhU is mandatory for any providers your agency credentials to distribute Leave Behind kits. Each agency should maintain a list of their credentialed providers.

Leave Behind Naloxone Procedure

After patient care is complete, while on the scene with the patient or bystanders, credentialed EMS providers may offer an Overdose Response Kit that contains two doses of nasal naloxone and information to seek recovery help and social services. Training for the public:

Supply

Leave Behind kits will be supplied by the Susquehanna Regional EMS Council Program Agency, to EMS agencies in the Susquehanna region (Broome, Chenango and Tioga Counties). Contact the Susquehanna Regional EMS Council Program Agency for supplies.

Distribution

- If naloxone was used prior to EMS arrival, an Overdose Response Kit can be given to resupply the patient.

- The Overdose Response Kits may be carried in any Certified EMS Agency vehicle in Susquehanna Region.
- These kits should not be used during EMS treatment of suspected opioid overdose unless absolutely necessary.
- If patient chooses to RMA, the Overdose Response Kit can still be given to the patient and/or an involved bystander.

Documentation

Documentation is key to success of the program - we must be able to track the number of doses that are distributed by EMS.

- In Imagetrend Elite- please answer the supplemental question- Was a Naloxone Kit left behind?
- In any other electronic documentation program please use the appropriate medication administration record and mode of delivery.
- Agencies that chose to participate will be required to send a short report each month with the number of kits left behind, via the SREMS website.
