# SUNY Upstate Critical Access Emergency Care Outreach Program

A National Collaborative Program for Rural and Critical Access Emergency Care

## Two Focused Sessions. One Unified Goal.

This program delivers hands-on, high-impact training for rural emergency care, with separate morning and afternoon sessions tailored to distinct audiences and a shared networking lunch that brings care teams together.

### Morning Session (4 hrs)

*For EMS & Prehospital Providers*

Field-based critical care and long-transport decision-making, with emphasis on protocol updates, scene leadership, communication, and hands-on skills for rural emergency response.

#### Key topics:

- ✓ NYS EMS protocol updates
- ✓ Airway, trauma, ultrasound, and resuscitation skills
- ✓ Managing high-acuity patients during prolonged transport
- ✓ Team-based simulation and debrief

### Networking Lunch

*Bridging Prehospital and In-Hospital Care*

A shared networking lunch connects both audiences, creating space for conversation, collaboration, and stronger continuity of care across rural emergency systems.

### Afternoon Session (4 hrs)

*For Physicians & APPs*

In-hospital decision-making in low-resource settings, emphasizing stabilization, advanced procedures, and leadership through real-world cases relevant to critical access hospitals.

#### Key topics:

- ✓ Stabilization and management of complex emergencies
- ✓ Advanced airway, trauma, and ultrasound skills
- ✓ Integrated case discussions and simulation
- ✓ Leadership and cross-disciplinary coordination
